Thank you again for helping and being flexible during drop off and pick up. We will need to continue this for at least the next 2 weeks. As you line up on Edmund Street, enter from Market Street towards Plater Street, be sure to stay on the right side of the street and have your flashers on if sitting still and your blinker on if you are ready to turn. It is our goal to keep everyone safe.

Although we have not seen snow yet, we have Faith in the Flakes. The Ground Hog said we have six more weeks of winter! Please be sure your student is dressed appropriately for the weather. Coats, hats and gloves are recommended. St. Joan of Arc follows the same procedures for closing and delays as Harford County Public School Systems. If schools are closed, there is **NO** Extended Care.


