#### **Spring Concert May 11**

- Band students only, arrive at the back entrance to the Church Hall at 6:00pm. Parents need to enter through the front Church doors at 6:15pm.
- 8th grade students report to Mrs. Dandino in the Church at 6:00pm
- PreK 7th grade students report to their classrooms in the school building at 6:10pm no earlier
- Church will open for parents at 6:15pm

PreK will perform first, then the Band then the K students. PreK and K students will be released to their parents after they sing. They may sit with their parents or leave to go home.

No students will return to the school building after the concert.

Teachers have notified students and parents what to wear for the concert.

#### **Uniforms**

Please check the uniform policy and be sure your student is in the correct uniform. The second layer for SJA is crew neck sweatshirt, sweater or SJA quarter zip. Please be sure this is the layer your student has with them.

#### Reminder of Cell Phone/Smart Watch Policy

Students are not allowed to have cell phones in the classrooms. Parents who wish their child(ren) to have a cell phone available to them must adhere to the following policy.

Any student who brings a cell phone/smart watch (or anything else that connects to the internet) to school must:

- 1. have the phone/watch clearly marked with their name
- 2. turn the phone off before exiting their vehicle and may be turned on after reentering their vehicle at the end of the school day
- 3. drop it/them off with their homeroom teacher upon arriving in the morning
- 4. pick it/them up at dismissal when exiting the building
- \*\*This policy is also in effect for school dances. Phones/smart watches must be turned in at the registration table

Those students who do not follow this policy will:

- 1. have the phone taken away and write a reflection. (first offense)
- 2. have the phone sent to the office. Parents must come in and meet with principal to pick up. (second offense)

Changes to uniform for 2023 -2024 school year: Kindergarten and Grade 1 students are to wear bucks with their regular uniform. Tennis shoes are to be worn on PE days.

The Harford County Health Department will be holding Hearing and Vision screenings for all students who would like to be evaluated. It is suggested that the screenings be completed when the child enters the school system (PreK- Kindergarten-Sixth Grade).

Hearing and Vision Screening will be conducted (by appointment only) in May and June of 2023 at the Harford County Health Department.

The location of the screening will be in the Harford County Health Department at 1 N. Main Street, Bel Air, MD 21014.

There is limited parking behind the building or curb parking along the front of the building. Children must be accompanied by a parent (or guardian over the age of 18 years) and must have the attached permission form completed and signed by the parent.
