RaiseRight

Mark your calendars! "Raise Days" on September 21-22 will have limited time bonuses on eGift cards and reloaded gift cards. Now is the time to stock up on eGift cards and reloadable gift cards and maximize earnings.

Log into RaiseRight app on Wednesday, September 20 to preview bonuses (preview is only available in app, not website). Now is the time to create a free account if you haven't already done so. Use the school code A9C13C7351446. Remember half your earnings can be applied to next year's tuition.

RaiseRight is unique in that you are not buying extra products - just gift cards for places for purchases you were already going to make. Check out the app and website to see how much could be earned from your own grocery shopping and essentials. School Safety

In our efforts to create a safe and nurturing environment for our students, we continue to look at ways to improve safety and for our students to feel safe on our campus. St. Joan of Arc, along with the other schools throughout the Archdiocese of Baltimore have adopted and will be utilizing the Standard Response Protocol throughout our campus this school year. The administration, teachers and staff have been trained in this protocol and have been teaching this to our students upon their return to school. Attached is information about the SRP.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND **GUARDIANS**

Our school has adopted The "I Love U Guys" Foundation's Standard Response Protocol (SRP). Students and staff will be training, practicing, and drilling the protocol.

COMMON LANGUAGE

The Standard Response Protocol (SRP) is based on an allhazards approach as opposed to individual scenarios. Like the Incident Command System (ICS), SRP utilizes clear common language while allowing for flexibility in protocol.

The premise is simple - there are five specific actions that can be performed during an incident. When communicating these, the action is labeled with a "Term of Art" and is then followed by a "Directive." Execution of the action is performed by active participants, including students, staff, teachers and first responders. The SRP is based on the following actions: Hold, Secure, Lockdown, Evacuate, and Shelter.

HOLD "In Your Classroom or Area"

Students are trained to:

• Clear the hallways and remain in their area or room until the "All Clear" is announced

Do business as usual

Adults and staff are trained to:

- Close and lock the door
- Account for students and adults
- Do business as usual

SECURE "Get Inside. Lock outside doors"

Students are trained to:

- Return to inside of building
- Do business as usual

Adults and staff are trained to:

- Bring everyone indoors
- Lock the outside doors
- Increase situational awareness
- Account for students and adults
- Do business as usual

Students are trained to: • Leave stuff behind if required to • If possible, bring their phone Follow instructions

Adults and staff are trained to:

Do not open the door

• Turn out the lights Move away from sight

Do not open the door

EVACUATE

• Prepare to evade or defend

Maintain silence

"To a Location"

Adults and staff are trained to:

Lock the classroom door

Recover students from hallway if possible

- Bring roll sheet and Go Bag (unless instructed not to bring anything with them, dependent on reason for evacuation.)
- Lead students to Evacuation location
- Account for students and adults
- Report injuries or problems using Red Card/Green • Card method.

SHELTER "State Hazard and Safety Strategy"

Hazards might include:

- Tornado
- Hazmat
- Earthquake
- Tsunami

Safety Strategies might include:

- Evacuate to shelter area •
- Seal the room
- Drop, cover and hold
- Get to high ground
- Students are trained in:
- Appropriate Hazards and Safety Strategies

Adults and staff are trained in:

- Appropriate Hazards and Safety Strategies
- Accounting for students and adults
- Report injuries or problems using Red Card/Green Card method.
