#### Science and Technology Institute

Applications are now open for the Joint Science and Technology Institute (JSTI) summer programs! JSTI is a fully funded entry-level research opportunity for middle and high school students interested in STEM. The program spans two weeks for high school students and one week for middle school students. The goal of JSTI is to provide students with an opportunity to engage in hands-on activities, team building, and research projects mentored by professional researchers while also gaining exposure to various STEM careers.

#### Weather related Closings/Delay Policy

St. Joan of Arc School follows the same procedures for school closing and delays as does **Harford County Public** School System. If Harford County schools close early because of inclement weather, SJA will do the same.


