In last week's newsletter we shared that on **March 10** Archbishop Lori will visit to dedicate and bless our new Chapel and Parish Life Center. Parents and students are invited to the Parish Life Center for the blessing followed by Liturgy. Students are asked to be in their formal school uniform for the dedication. Students and parents need to arrive at 9:30am. Please park in the school lot and enter through the main entrance – (same entrance as the students enter in the mornings.) We will gather in the new gym for a blessing by Archbishop Lori. After the blessing students and their parents may move to the Church for the 11:15am liturgy. A reception in the Church Hall will follow the Liturgy. Families may also tour the Chapel and Parish Life Center until 2:00pm.

We believe the problem with the SWIFT K notification system has been fixed. We will send out a test notification on February 29 at 10:30am. Please contact the office if you do not receive the email or text message.

Update from the Archdiocese of Baltimore- Chapter 11 Process Information

The Archdiocese of Baltimore is in a Chapter 11 Reorganization process and as we all work through these steps, there are some items that the parish/school is doing to fulfill the court ordered requirements. One of those requirements is for all parishes and schools to make public that a final date has been decided upon that will serve as a deadline for anyone who has a claim, to submit it to the court. The budget has been developed and tuition has been set for the **2024 - 2025** school year. There is a tuition increase of \$150.00 this year, approximately 1.7%. This is to accommodate adequate compensation for our faculty. In order to recruit and retain highly qualified educators, we are working towards compensation at 80% of the rate for Baltimore County teachers. We are grateful to our faculty for their commitment to Catholic Education.

- The Catholic Tuition Discount Form must be submitted each year in order to qualify for the Catholic discount of \$1,000.00 per child.
- A Multi Child Discount is given in this way: a \$500.00 discount for two children; a \$1,250.00 discount for three children; a \$2,250.00 discount for four children, and \$3500.00 discount for five children.
- 8th grade fee is \$200.00. Final payment is due by April 15, 2025

ALL FAMILIES ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN UP AND MAKE PAYMENT THROUGH FACTS utilizing automatic bank payments (EFT) or by credit card. (*There is an additional fee for processing the credit card option). Easy and convenient online registration is available.

FACTS Grant and Aid

Tuition Assistance for the 2024-25 School Year is available through the Archdiocese of Baltimore for all families who qualify. To apply, please visit the FACTS Grant and Aid website at www.factstuitionaid.com. FACTS Grant and Aid application fee is \$35.00. The deadline to apply for Archdiocesan Assistance is February 28, 2024. FACTS will require the submission of 2022 Tax Return and 2023 W2.

Additional assistance is available through St. Joan of Arc School and Parish. The process of using FACTS will be the same for AOB or local assistance distribution. Our goal is to help all families afford a Catholic education for their children. Additional funds are available through **Broadening Options and Opportunities for Students Today (BOOST) Program** for those students who qualify by income.
