Third-Going-To-Fourth Grade Summer Work Packet

Research shows that during the summer, students lose about 1/3 of what they have learned if they do not continue using their acquired knowledge. In an effort to avoid the "Summer Slump" students are asked to follow the reading and math summer work. It will count as their first grade in the fall.
