Upcoming Scholarship Opportunity for the 2024-2025 School Year

The Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary will have two \$250.00 scholarships for this coming school year (2024/2025). One for rising 4th and 5th graders, and another for rising 6th, 7th, & 8th graders.

In order to apply each candidate must have the following qualifications:

- Have a Veteran in their family (living or deceased) who was honorably discharged.
- Applicants must be United States Citizens

In order to apply, candidates need to:

- Submit a 2-4 paragraph essay on their Veteran family member, or write about what Patriotism means to them OR Draw a picture of their Veteran family member with an explanation of what Patriotism means to them.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a community leader (teacher, priest, scout leader, etc.).
- All submissions need to be turned into St. Joan of Arc School Main Office with the candidate's First Name, Last Name, and Grade by September 11, 2024.
- Winners will be presented with their certificates at the Trimester 1 award ceremony.
