Protagonist Pennant Includes:

- Character's name in large font
- An image of the protagonist or an image that represents the protagonist
- 5 descriptive character traits
- Identifying the antagonist.
- A notable character quote

SETTING



Setting Pennant Includes:

- Identifying time and place of TWO major scenes in the story.
- An image of EACH scene
- Identifying the mood of each scene.

CONFLICT

Conflict Pennant Includes:

- Describing two major conflicts in the story.
- Identifying each conflict as either internal or external.
- Images and graphics to represent each conflict.

RESOLUTION

Resolution Pennant Includes:

- Describing the solution to the protagonist's problem and the conflict being resolved.
- Describing a main character's internal or external growth.
- Images and graphics to represent the resolution.
