Blessing of the Animals - Feast Day of St. Francis of Assisi

Parents may bring their pets to be blessed on October 3rd. Please follow the guidelines listed for the blessing.

- Parents need to notify their student's teacher that they are attending the pet blessing.
- Pets need to be leashed or in a crate.
- Parents may arrive at 2pm with their pets and pull into the normal dismissal lot
- Teachers will be on duty to direct cars like normal dismissal.
- Lot will close at 2:15 for safety.
- Parents and pets will exit their cars and move to the grassy area next to the playground/parish center.
- Pet blessing will start promptly at 2:30
- After blessing students will return in school for dismissal and parents will return to cars
