### A note from Mr. Schmitz



Dear SJA Parents and Families,

It is hard to believe, but this will be the last Newsletter for the 2024-2025 school year. If you had asked me last June 4 where I would be this June 4, this would probably not have been an answer I would have come up with, but it has been wonderful to be back in a school and working with your children. They bring joy to every day.

Today, we completed our last required drill, a tornado drill in which students move to the hallways, away from windows, sit on the floor with knees up, and cover their heads. The students were compliant and took the drill seriously. The reporting required by the state and by the Archdiocese will show that all of our emergency drills have been completed for the year.

We are in the process of hiring an assistant principal, an experienced Catholic school teacher and administrator who is moving to this area from California. I look forward to introducing her in the fall when she has moved in and gotten settled.

I would like us to have a focus next year of having students to school before 8:10 so that they can be in homerooms, and ready for morning prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance as soon I get in from greeting kids on the parking lot. I know that sometimes traffic and trains slow down the process of arriving, but I would like to start our instructional day with an increased sense of urgency for learning. I am thinking about putting together a committee of parents, students and teachers to look at our uniform moving forward after next year. If you are interested in participating, let me know. I only need a couple of people, and I don't anticipate that it will be a huge time commitment.

### Parish Picnic


On Sunday, June 8th, we will be having our Pastorate Picnic. Please join us for picnic food, games, and music as well. Please invite your friends and family to join us.




