Dear SJA Parents and Families,

We have a lot coming up! In the Catholic Church, October is a special month dedicated to the Holy Rosary in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a time in the Liturgical Calendar called Ordinary Time, during which the Church celebrates the earthly ministry of Jesus. Similarly, we meditate on the Mystery of Jesus as we pray the Rosary. The Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7. Because our school Mass is on Wednesday, we will celebrate on October 8. Other dates to note:

October 1 – Scout Uniform Day. Any Boy or Girl Scout, Cub Scout or Brownie can wear their Scout uniform to school on this Wednesday.

October 2 – We will have the Blessing of the Animals 2:30-2:45, on the lawn next to the Parish. Families can park in the lot and bring the pets. All students meet on the lawn in front of the Parish Office. Kids who cannot bring pets may bring a photo or drawing of their favorite animal; - October 2 is also school photo day. All students should wear their dress uniforms, but students who have PE that day – Kindergarten, and 4 th , 5 th , and 7 th grades – should wear their normal PE shoes so they can be on the gym floor without marring it; - Finally, on October 2, we are having a visit from the Maryland Terrapin Program, with mini-lessons throughout the day so that students can learn about the Diamondback Terrapin, a native Maryland animal.

October 3 - School closed; Archdiocese of Baltimore Professional Development Day

October 8: Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary - We will celebrate with a procession at the start of Mass and a closing offering of flowers from each class to the Blessed Mother. We encourage you to join us!

October 10 - Home School Association Bingo!

October $17 - \frac{1}{2}$ day for student

October 24 - 5:00 to 7:00, Trunk or Treat; 6:00 to 8:00 Middle School Social

October 29 – All Saints School Mass (All Saints Day is November 1!) featuring our 2 nd grade Saints; 4:00 – 8:00 Evening parent-teacher conferences via Zoom

October 30: Culmination Activity for the Month of the Rosary - Students will gather in the Parish Life Center/Gym to create a living Rosary. All grades will have a role in this unique prayer service that creates a physical representation of a Rosary as we pray. Also, October 30 is a half- day for students, with class parties 11:00 to 12:00; and afternoon in-person parent – teacher conferences. At the end of last school year, I solicited interest in a committee to look at uniform options going forward. The committee met last week. I will process the feedback received and advise of changes we will make based on the committee's discussion. Consideration was given at the meeting for parent ease and expense, and along those lines, we may streamline the uniform options.
