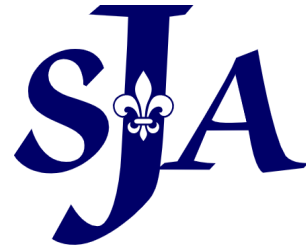

Dear SJA Parents and Families,

It seems as if I was just writing to wish you a happy summer vacation, and here it is already time to write to welcome everyone back. I hope you had a most enjoyable summer. I want to share a few things as we get ready to begin. We are fully staffed in terms of teachers. If you are aware of someone who would be interested in working as a PreK3 Instructional Assistant, a Kindergarten Instructional Assistant, or in our Extended Care Program, please encourage them to visit the Archdiocese of Baltimore website to apply: <https://www.archbalt.org/employment/>.

We are welcoming several new teachers this year. They are listed elsewhere in the newsletter, and Mrs. Maid is assembling a more formal introductory page to share with you.

The Archdiocese has encouraged us to execute an evacuation drill and fire drill early in the school year, so your child may tell you within the first couple of weeks of school that we have conducted one of these. We are required by law to conduct ten fire drills per year, so getting a solid start on those before cold weather hits is desirable. This year, as previously, I will let you know when we are planning lock down drills so that you can prepare your child if he or she is likely to feel anxious during these events.

Along the lines of school safety, and mindful of the tragedy which occurred in Minneapolis at the beginning of last school year, the Archdiocese issued a lengthy set of protocols for school Masses held in conjunction with the Parish. Reluctantly, after reviewing these with Fr. Francis and Fr. Franz, we have decided to have our school Masses in the school, and they will be for faculty and students only. We are sorry for any inconvenience or disappointment this causes. We will continue to maintain our Catholic identity, and celebrate various school liturgy and sacramental experiences throughout the year, notwithstanding the school Mass parameters.

Next Wednesday, August 26 at 3:30 in the PLC, we will once again host our Step Up to Middle School event to help rising 6th graders and their parents become comfortable with the expectations of Middle School. Students will begin with a group of our 8th grade students for fun activities, and then be able to ask questions about work load, the difference in assignments, etc. Parents will begin with middle school teachers, and will be able to ask questions about the

changes middle school will introduce into students' workloads, schedule, school day, etc. At the end, we will bring everyone together briefly to allow questions from parents to 8th graders, and students to teachers.

We are excited to see our students again, and we wish all of you a happy and successful new school year.

ARRIVAL / DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

Arrival

Arrive on Plater Street lining up close to the curb – ***NO CARS ARE TO BE DOUBLE PARKED– EITHER ALONG THE BUILDING OR PARKING LOT. Please do not block the crosswalks.***

Turn right into the alley off of Plater St. , but do not discharge students until you make a LEFT turn into the DROP-OFF ZONE on the parking lot. Please exit out onto Edmund Street.

Students will exit the vehicles on the passenger side and will be helped by safety patrol students and staff to proceed safely into the main entrance of the school.

AT NO TIME SHOULD A PARENT EXIT THE CAR IN THE DROP OFF ZONE.

All traffic will exit the parking lot onto Edmund Street. ***PLEASE DO NOT PASS OTHER CARS IN THE DROP OFF ZONE AS THIS POSES A DANGER TO STUDENTS.***

No student should be dropped off prior to 7:50 AM as there is no adult supervision until that time. Parents may enroll in Extended Care if they must drop off their child earlier.

Dismissal Procedures

Vehicles are to turn right to enter the parking lot through the alley entrance on Plater Street only. Vehicles will be lined up in rows beginning at the residential side of the lot. (Parents are asked not to arrive prior to **2:30pm** as physical education classes are conducted on this lot.)

Upon arrival parents should wait along Plater Street until the lot is open. ***NO CARS ARE TO BE DOUBLE PARKED– EITHER ALONG THE BUILDING OR PARKING LOT. Please do not block the crosswalks and driveways.***

The rows will be dismissed through the Edmund Street exit. **ALL CARS MUST EXIT WHEN DIRECTED ASKED TO DO SO.** *If your child is not yet in the car, you must exit the parking lot and re enter through the Plater Street entrance.*

Since no child may be left unattended, students not picked up 15 minutes after dismissal time will be sent to Extended Care and parents will be charged for at least one hour according to the Extended Care fees. Students will only be released to custodial parents or those on the emergency contact list.

The school office will be closed from 2:45-3:15PM daily to ensure safe and timely dismissal for all students. The last entry into school for early dismissal will be no later than 2:30 . This means the phones will not be answered and no more early sign outs are allowed.

PikMyKid Dismissal App

The PikMyKid app is required for all families to help ensure a safe, secure, and efficient dismissal process.

New Families:

Please download the PikMyKid app to your mobile device before the start of the school year. You will be designated as the Primary Parent and will manage your child's dismissal through the app.

At the beginning of the school year, each student will receive a PikMyKid Car Tag containing a unique ID number and QR code. Please keep this tag in your vehicle and provide a copy to anyone authorized to pick up your child.

Parents may delegate pickup privileges to alternate individuals through the app. We strongly encourage all authorized pickup persons to download the PikMyKid app as well. When arriving for pickup, the app will send a matching student ID number to the authorized individual's phone, allowing school staff to verify that the correct person is picking up the correct child.

For families participating in carpools, the app will display the ID numbers for all students assigned to that vehicle, helping us ensure a smooth and accurate dismissal process for everyone.

SJA School Calendar

All St. Joan of Arc School events will be posted on the online school calendar available through the school website. We encourage all families to sync their mobile devices and personal calendars to the school calendar to stay informed about upcoming events and activities.

Because this is a live calendar, updates and additions may occur throughout the school year. Please check the calendar regularly, especially on a weekly basis, to ensure you have the most current information regarding school events, activities, and important dates.

FACTS

All families are required to have a FACTS account. This account is initially set up through School Admin during the registration process. FACTS is the platform all Archdiocesan schools use for tuition payments and incidental expenses (field trips, novels, extended care, etc.) There are two sections within your FACTS account. One for tuition and the other for incidental expenses.

Tuition payments are automatically withdrawn from your designated account. The incidental account can be set up as automatic withdrawals or you may go in and pay when billed.

Please note if you need to reschedule a tuition payment you must contact Pam Franke 3 business days prior to the scheduled payment date.

Track It Forward is the program we use to track family volunteer hours throughout the school year. Each family is required to complete **20 volunteer hours per school year**. We offer many opportunities throughout the school year to volunteer as well as make donations to earn volunteer hours.

Families with whom do not complete their volunteer hours will be billed through their **FACTS account at the end of the school year** at a rate of **\$10.00 per incomplete hour**, up to a maximum of 20 hours.

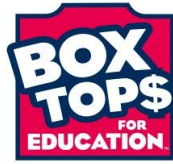
